5. Sophia Williams

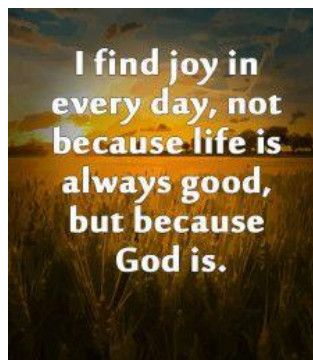
