If your child has a temperature over 100.5, is experiencing coughing spells, is listless and tired more than usual, or any other symptom that is out of the ordinary for them, please DO NOT send them to school. I realize that keeping children home for what might be a cold is inconvenient when you have to work, but when it is not a cold but indeed covid, then your child has exposed the entire school population.

If your child is experiencing any of the above symptoms or has been directly exposed, they will be expected to get a covid test or stay home for 10 days. We must also receive documentation showing that your child has tested negative, we cannot just be told that they were cleared to return. We are trying to remain in person this school year and need everyone to aid in this happening. We need to continue to pray for our school and community during this unprecedented time.
