Fun for a Rainy Day:

Kinetic Sand

Materials:

- Baking Soda
- Baking Powder
- Dishwashing Liquid
- Mixing Bowl
- Spoon

Instructions:

1. Mix together two parts baking soda and one part baking powder along with one part of dishwashing liquid in a large bowl.
2. Stir the mixture with a spoon until a sandy/doughy substance forms. If the powder mixture seems too wet, add baking powder.
3. Knead the mixture until it feels sandy and dough-like but not wet. If needed, add more baking powder to make the mixture fluffy.
4. Store the mixture in a sealed plastic container.
