
Demerit Policy

In order to keep students accountable for their own behavior, CCCS will issue demerits for certain offences.

Once a student receives 5 demerits, they will be required to stay after school until 4:30. After that student accumulates 10 demerits, they will be required to serve 3 hours here at the school on a Saturday. There will also be a \$10 fee charged. This fee will go to the person that has to take time from their Saturday to supervise the student.

There will be a phone call and written correspondence will be sent home so you know when your child will be staying.

Cell Phones and Toys

Students were reminded this week that cell phones are to remain in their lockers during school. If a student needs to be contacted, please call the office. Earbuds and headsets are NOT permitted in school. Please keep ALL toys at home, nothing should be brought to school as it is a distraction this includes pop-its.

Recess

It's getting to be that time of year when we have to think about wearing jackets or sweatshirts.

As long as it isn't raining, the students will be going outside for recess. If the temperature is 60 or below, they MUST have a jacket. If they don't they may get cold during recess. We don't want any of them getting sick. Please check the forecast and have your child dress accordingly. One idea would be to have them bring an "extra" sweatshirt to be left in their locker.



Morning Drop Offs

Beginning October 4, no student will be permitted to enter the building before 8:15 a.m. The busing companies have been notified. If you supply transportation for your child, please don't bring them before this time. Classes don't begin until 8:30 a.m. and the teachers have devotions and preparations for their day once they arrive and these few minutes are very valuable.

Emergency Cards

You have received an emergency card that was sent home with your student. Please complete

these in PENCIL. If you use PENCIL, changes can be made year-to-year and

you don't have to complete a new one.

We need a card for each student on file.

Lunches

Sometimes we know that lunches will be forgotten. Rather than having them call home, we will have peanut & butter jelly sandwiches & fruit available here just in case.

Also, when packing your child's lunch, please make sure they have the utensils they'll need. If you'd like, send in a pack of plastic spoons and/or napkins and we will keep them for sharing with others.

Middle school & High school students should try to avoid needing to use a microwave. There is only 1 microwave available. By the time several students "cook" their lunch, the lunch period is over. Put their food in a thermos if they want hot food.

Because of the time restrictions, elementary students are not permitted to use/have someone use the microwave.

Remember, there is a variety of milk that can be purchased every day for \$.50 and iced tea or lemonade for \$1.



Medication



Please be advised that NO medication will be dispensed by the staff or faculty at CCCS.

This includes cough drops, tums, Tylenol/ibuprophen. The only thing the teachers/staff will be able to "treat" are cuts & scrapes or give the student an ice pack.

If your child has a prescription medication, it **MUST** be sent to the school in the original bottle with the instructions printed on it. The nurse from Central Cambria will then be notified and she will dispense the medicine.

This is not our rule. It is actually a state law.

Dismissal

Here are a few things you need be aware of:

- ◇ **All** dismissals will take place at the school.
- ◇ If your child usually rides the bus and you are picking them up, we **MUST** have it in writing. We'd love to believe everything the kids tell us, but sometimes it just isn't accurate.
- ◇ If you are picking up your child, please "show your face" to the teacher dismissing. This will help us in knowing where the students are at all times.
