Pertaining to the covid letter that was sent, we would like to hopefully add some clarity.

To try to hold covid to a minimum, we are doing several steps in the classrooms. We are fogging the classrooms and also wiping down desks, chairs, switches, and handles.

We ask that your child be kept home if they are showing symptoms of covid. Not just if they may have been exposed. This would include a temperature of 100.5, coughing, or sickness in general.

We also seem to have the flu bug going around and unfortunately the symptoms are the same as covid, but these symptoms usually only last 2-3 days.

If you are sure your child has covid, then the quarantine period would be 10 days.

If you think they have the flu and they are better in 2-3 days and want them back in school, we ask that you do a covid test with your doctor for a home test to be sure

It is our intent to have in-person instruction for as long as possible.

If you would want your child to wear a mask, please let us know.
